



NOTICE FROM THE FEDERAL TRADE COMMISSION OF THE UNITED STATES

If You Were Prescribed Suboxone® Film, You May Be Eligible for a Payment

Apply by December 1, 2020

The Federal Trade Commission (FTC) reached settlements totaling **\$60 million** with the companies responsible for **Suboxone®**, a prescription drug used to treat opioid addiction. The FTC says that these companies violated antitrust laws by preventing patients from choosing lower-priced generic versions of the drug. The FTC is the nation's consumer protection agency.

If you were prescribed Suboxone film in the United States between March 1, 2013 and February 28, 2019, you may be eligible for a payment. Apply at ftc.gov/suboxone by **December 1, 2020**.
